

Ride Directions

Important-Please contact Joan and Bill by March 1 if you plan on going on the ride.

To ensure rates, reservations for overnight accommodations must be made by March 4th.

Date: Wednesdsay, April 23 & 24, 2008, 10:00 a.m.

Destination: Harris Neck Wildlife Refuge and Jekyll Island (Overnight).

Directions to the departure point: We will leave Hilton Head allowing 1 1/2 hours for the drive. We will meet at the office of Harris Neck at 10:00 a.m.

Drive south on I-95 to Exit 67, go south on #17 for one mile to Harris Neck Road and turn left continuing to the entrance of Harris Neck Wildlife Refuge and proceed to the office for parking.

A description of the Wednesday ride: Because the report has come to us LOUD and CLEAR...we will stay on the paved roads only and park our bikes and walk to see the Wood Storks and also to explore the original plantation which was there before WW II when the area was used as a training base for the Air Force.

Wednesday Lunch arrangements: We will have lunch at the Sapelo Station before driving on to Jekyll Island.

Overnight Arrangements: At Jekyll we will be staying at the <u>Oceanside Inn</u> (1-866-5JEKYLL), across the street from the Quality Inn. We will gather in the McHenry's suite for beverages and... before going to dinner. BYOB and any contributions you choose to bring! We will be eating dinner at the adjacent Sand Bar Grill. The next morning we will have a light??? breakfast before our ride.

A description of the Thursday ride: We will ride the beautiful trails of Jekyll Island.
