

Ride Directions

Important-Please contact Carole or John by Tuesday if you plan on going on the ride and having lunch.

Date: Thursday, June 12, 2008, 9:30 a.m.

Destination: Hunting Island.

Directions to the departure point: From Hilton Head go West on 278 for about 11 miles. Take 170 for about 14 miles towards Beaufort to 802. At the 802 junction turn right onto 802 towards Parris Island and Port Royal. Continue on 802 for about 5 miles. At the 802/21 junction turn right onto 21 for about 3 miles towards Hunting Island & Fripp Island. Turn right onto 21S for approximately 15 miles to the park entrance. Go through the park entrance then proceed to parking lot C at the lighthouse.

There is an entrance fee into the park. Those under 65 are charged \$4 per person. For us South Carolina geriatric ward residents (65 & over) the cost is \$2.50. Our looks aren't good enough proof, so we need to show a South Carolina picture ID to prove our age and residence.

From the Sea Pines circle the trip took us 1 hour and 15 minutes. Total distance from the bridge is about 50 miles.

A description of the ride: Hunting Island is a natural and rustic State Park. The entire ride will be within the park mostly on paved roads. None of the ride will be on the beach. We'll have pit stops at the visitor center and the nature museum. The ride will be about ten miles.

Lunch arrangements: Berry Island Restaurant (on route 802)

From Hunting Island go about 15 miles towards Beaufort to the first traffic light, then go right onto Route 802 for 1.4 miles to Newpoint Road on the left. The restaurant is immediately on the right within the cluster of white buildings.

Alternate luncheon plans: In the event of rain, we will dine at Longhorn's – South Island Square, on William Hilton Parkway (278) one mile south of Palmetto Dunes. We will assemble at 11:45.
