

Ride Directions

Date: Thursday, June 2, 2011, 10:00 a.m.

Destination: Historic Darien, Georgia.

Directions to the departure point: Proceed to route 95 and go south to exit 49. At the end of the ramp turn left. Go 1.3 +/- miles to stop sign. Turn right onto route 17 south. Continue on 17 to the intersection just before the bridge (after the blinking Traffic Light) and turn left on King George Rd. for 1.1+/- miles to Fort King George (c.1721). We will park to the left of the fort entrance where you'll see fencing which says RV parking. Please park diagonally there.

If you go over the bridge you have gone too far. (Following the signs on route 17 to Fort King George is a longer way.)

A description of the ride: We will ride on bike paths and on some roads with usually no traffic. Darien is a historic town established in 1736, the second oldest planned town in Georgia. You will have a chance to see historic sites, shrimp boats, etc. and after lunch to tour the Fort and nearby sites in the afternoon as you like.

Lunch arrangements: Lunch will be at The Purple Pickle (a most unusual place) at 11:45 a.m.
