

## Ride Plan

Important – If you plan to ride, please notify the Ride Leader by the TUESDAY before the Thursday ride. Also indicate if you are having lunch.

**Date**: Thursday, February 27, 2014, 10:00 a.m.

**Destination**: Tybee Island, GA. **Be aware that the driving time from midisland Hilton Head to Tybee is about 1 hour and 15 minutes**.

**Directions to the departure point**: Take US 278 west to Moss Creek stoplight. Turn left on Buckingham Plantation Dr and continue to Bluffton Parkway and take a right onto the parkway. Stay on the parkway until you reach Simmonsville Rd. Turn left on Simmonsville. Stay on Simmonsville until you reach May River Road (SC 46) and take a right. Stay on SC 46 until you come to the traffic circle. Go through the circle and continue on SC 170 until you come to US 17. Turn left on 17 and continue to the Talmage Bridge. Take the first exit after crossing the bridge to Oglethorpe Avenue. Continue on Oglethorpe for two blocks to Martin Luther King Boulevard where you will turn left. Continuing north on King Boulevard for about 2 blocks to Bay Street where you will turn right. Continue on Bay Street for several blocks until it becomes President Street. Turn left at this light and you are now on GA 80. While the names may change on GA 80, it will continue on to Tybee. After you get on Tybee Island continue until you come to the first traffic light at Campbell Avenue where you will turn left. A Chevron Station is on the left corner and the Visitors Center a pink building--is on the right corner (the GPS address is 802 1st Street, Tybee Island, GA). There is a restroom at the visitor's center. Continue on Campbell until you reach a yellow house at the end of the street. Turn right on Van Horn and almost immediately turn left into the parking lot for Jaycee Park.

A description of the ride: Almost all of this ride will be on streets with varying levels of traffic. We hope that the traffic will be minimal due to the time of year. The ride will be about 10-12 miles and there will be restrooms available along the way. Restrooms are available at the visitor's center 802 1st Street you come in if needed.

Lunch arrangements: Lunch will be at about 11:30 at the delightful Sundae Café located at 304 First Street. This is a very popular local restaurant so please let the trip leaders know by Tuesday if you plan to have lunch because reservations must to be made.
