Ride the Greenway after lunch

The Greenway meanders throughout the city and many of its neighborhoods. We will start the ride at the Riverview Park Soccer fields. There is no GPS address but this is the closest address

800 Riverview Park Drive North Augusta, SC If you take the next left on Hammonds Ferry Road you will see the soccer parking lot and restrooms on the left. Park in the parking lot.

This ride is almost exactly 12 miles round trip and has a slight incline from the beginning of the ride to the end of the pathway where we will turn around and go back. If you wish to only ride the downhill portion of the ride, the starting point would be at the trailhead on Bergen Rd. At the intersection of Bergen Rd and Five Notch Rd, follow Bergen Rd to the Greenway parking lot on the left. Note that if you are only riding downhill, someone will need to drive your car back to the start of the trail to pick you up.

Ride Mill Village and River Levee Trails 9:00 a.m.

Meet in hotel lobby to drive to the starting point for the ride. Starting point for Mill Village Canal Trail ride is the Kroc Center 1833 Broad Street, Augusta, GA. We will park on the Eve Street side of the Kroc Center. This will be about an 11 mile ride beside the canal and Lake Olmstead as well as the Savannah River. It is all paved pathways with just a short stretch on low traffic streets.

Savannah River Site Tour 12:30 p.m.

The Savannah River Site (SRS) is a key Department of Energy (DOE) industrial complex responsible for stewardship of the environment, the enduring nuclear weapons stockpile and nuclear materials. More specifically, SRS processes and stores nuclear materials in support of the national defense and U.S. nuclear non-proliferation efforts. The Site also develops and deploys technologies to improve the environment and treat nuclear and hazardous wastes left from the Cold War.

All tours begin and end at the Applied Research Center, located at 301 Gateway Drive, Aiken, S.C. 29803. It is about a ½ hour drive from our lunch location. You do not need to be at the Applied Research Center prior to 12:30 PM. An SRS overview begins at 1:00 PM, with the tour immediately following. The tour will conclude at approximately 4:30 PM.
